## Are you suffering from 5 or more of the following symptoms?

1. Depressed mood
2. Lack of interest in pleasure in all or most activities
3. Significant weight loss or gain
4. Not being able to sleep/sleeping way too much
5. Fatigue or loss of energy
6. Recurrent thoughts of death
7. Difficulty thinking or concentrating
8. The above symptoms not due to substance abuse or another medical condition
9. Anxiety from being displaced from a disaster
